A 2012 state audit found that the Fitchburg authority had long waiting lists for housing, slow unit turnover, high vacancy rates, and neglected properties.
Since then, the authority and its Board of Directors

have been working to address those issues. Bushman knew coming into the position that the Fitchburg authority has its

challenges.
Previous management
was archaic and siloed, he
said, but Bushman wants to
have an open system that
empowers staff. So far, staff
members have been

responding well, he said.
Bushman looking forward to turning it around like he did in Marlboro, where he served as the city's housing chief for 7 years.
"I feel like my whole career has led up to this point," he said. "(The plan) will get us to the point where we're not just tread-

ing water, but we're succeeding."
